- Waukesha/Ozaukee County trails policy change regarding caches
 - Previously contacted Johnny Waypoint about why no new caches being approved on trails
 - May be due to work going on, on the trails
 - Will have to get information on how to proceed with Waukesha County
 - No new updates as of August
 - Discussion about cache placement on trails, WEnergies does not want caches on their property
 - Plan to make an attempt with Ozaukee County and WEnergies to gain permission to place caches on Interurban Trail/Power Line trail
 - buttersfamily89 wasn't able to be provided contact with Wisconsin Electric as an individual reaching out. WGA will reach out to them in fall to see if open to discussing with an organization.
- Ice Age Trail cache approvals
 - Sensitive areas on trails, trail work in progress, and landowner easement issues...leaving on agenda

 - TB Race
 - 11 racers actively racing from original drop – The group of caches have been dropped off in different caches now, hopefully race will get more interesting.
 - advertise next year TB race for next year where racers can drop off at Cache Bash – Jen will send out notice, Maverick will bring a clear ammo box to collect racers at WB.
 - “European Vacation” race - possible local cacher who is going to Greece in March to help kick off an individual race or associated with WGA – HOLD TO PROMOTE TIL SPRING
 - Maverick is road tripping in September towards the west, idea is to put each in paper bag for random drop
 - plan to purchase more trackable tags from Space Coast to have available at campout to have more racers.
 - West Bend
 - WB contact has been working with Mike on details
 - geocaching101 – to be held Friday at 11am – near stage area – table available (possibly picnic table)
 - received feedback from Cache Bash committee that EarthCache 101 idea probably won't work....most people will check in and leave park starting at noon

 - Tim has taken the food training
 - Grocery pickup need to be done for pancake breakfast – Jodi (pancake mix) and Jen (main order)
 - Updating the square tool to remove sizes/other details to make easier search – Jen
 - Signs – Jen will look into

 - Will put out call for volunteers for booth tasks and pancake breakfast - done

 - Jennifer mentioned a challenge point checker in ProjectGC as a method to use.
 - Jen sent out survey email to members
 - Reviewed survey feedback at high level
 - Justin is looking into WGA site code to make updates that may be able to incorporate something for LCG.
 - Change in prizes? Tiered prizes? Decision to not have monthly prizes.
 - Jen communicated with Chris about idea changes, Marie has drafted a new layout of rules so they are not so daunting.
